ANNOUNCES II OPEN CALL VR 2018-2019

1. Description of the competition

II Open Call The VR-exhibition is of a competition and is aimed at creators, graduates and students of art academies and enthusiasts. The aim of the competition is to organize an exhibition of works made in the Virtual Reality. Selected exhibitions will be realized in the OFUTURE Zone on Kaponiera, Roosevelta Street in Poznań/Poland, as part of the entire exhibition program for the fourth quarter of 2018 or 2019.

The organizer is Czapski Art Foundation with headquarters at Szubińska Street 18 in Poznań.

Proposals for submitted exhibitions may be individual or group.

Technique of works: Virtual Reality.

Any subject is available.

2. Rules of participation

The person submitting the exhibition project completes the application form, posted on Facebook and the organizer's website. In the case of an individual exhibition, the applicant is the artist himself.

In the case of a group, one artist has to be chosen by the group. One person can send one application form, that is one exhibition project. When filling out the form, please follow the instructions.

The completed competition form should be sent by 31/10/2018 to the email address: ofuture@czapski.art.pl by entering the II Open Call VR in the subject of the message and your competition nickname from the application form.

The form must be accompanied by an attachment / file sent via wetransfer or e-mail, which will serve the members of the jury as a visual material. Uploaded materials will not be returned.

Submission of the application for participation in the competition is tantamount to acknowledgment of these regulations and consent to the processing of the project author's data for purposes related to this recruitment. Participants of the competition declare that the presented project is their own, original.

3. Evaluation

The selection of the winning offer will be made by the competition jury. Criteria for the assessment of jury members: the idea and subject of the exhibition, the time and technical possibilities of space, the cost of the exhibition. The decision will be taken by the jury after getting acquainted with the submitted projects. Each of the jury members will award points to only ten of their best projects from all the proposals submitted. Scoring for selected proposals from 1 to 10 points, where 1 is the lowest and 10 is the highest score.

The organizer of the Open Call reserves the right to individual consultations with the tenderers regarding the manner in which the exhibitions are sent from the submitted

works [like the period, the IT equipment involved for the projection of VR works and the arrangement of the exhibitions].

Selected offers will be shown at the opening exhibition of OFUTURE Zone, from November 24, 2018 to December 20, 2018. Possible projection periods in 2019 will be agreed in an agreement with the bidder.

4. Results

The results of the competition procedure will be announced by November 14, 2018 on the website and Facebook organizer. The winners will be notified via email. The applicant who receives the total number of points in the competition procedure receives a 1,500 PLN gross [350 Euro] reward and the implementation of the exhibition. The applicant with the second highest number of points receives a 500 PLN gross [120 Euro] award and the implementation of the exhibition. In the event that the winning entry is not carried out, the prize will be forfeited and will not pass to the next highest scoring proposal.
